9. Secretary – Membership and Communication

**Important Dates:**

1. Last date for nomination submission: October 28, 2017 (Saturday), 6:00 pm
2. Disclosing the list of Nominees: October 30, 2017, (Monday, midnight)
3. Last date for withdrawal of nomination: November 11, 2017 (Saturday), 6:00 pm
4. Declaration of final list of candidates: November 12, 2017 (Sunday, midnight)

**Candidate Eligibility:**

1. The candidate must be a Regular Member in good standing or a Life Member of BCAS, while submitting the nomination (Bylaws article 6).

**Voter Eligibility:**

1. *Regular Member* in good standing or a *Life Member* of BCAS can vote (Bylaws article 6.1).

2. Default *Regular Member* will be able to vote upon payment of all dues before election (Bylaws article 12.3.9.2). Payment will be accepted on Election Day at the polling booth.
3. New membership application will be accepted on Election Day. Refer to Bylaws article 12.3.9.3 and 12.3.9.4 for requirements and conditions.
4. A voter must requires to present a *personal identification* card (health card, SIN card, driver's license, citizenship card, PR card, or any government issued ID) to the Election Commission to vote [Bylaws article 12.3.15].
